CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT.

AN ACT making an appropriation from the reclamation revolving fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the reclamation revolving fund for the department of conservation and development:

For contract and bond purposes.....\$3,000,000
